On Entry Data Analysis (Amanda/Nikki Valentini -co-opted presenter)	Amanda – Literacy Greenwood Pre-Primary students are following the state trends in some areas for literacy. Literacy areas follow the normal bell curve – large numbers of students are 'middle of the road'. As with previous years, area of speaking and listening is strong. In Reading, we are not that high as far as fluency and decoding goes. Letter and sound knowledge falls in the low-mid range. This then impacts on the ability to phonetically decode. In writing they are mostly stringing letters together. There are only a few phonetic writers, but not many. Results indicate the Pre-Primary students seemed to be placed very well this year in relation to ability. Strong Oral language development is evident which is critical for all of the above trends. Greenwood Year 3 NAPLAN shows that our students work well off this very strong Oral language base. Peter noted that this cohort, as a kindergarten group, had more issues relating to referral to speech/OT and paediatric issues than previous cohorts.	

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	Nikki – Maths Year 1 Year 1 and 2 do not get state comparison for data as On Entry is not mandated for these year levels. Discussed strategies teachers in K-2 are using to address areas of need for students in relation to data from On Entry testing. Teachers were provided with time to discuss school trends and year level trends. Emphasis has been strongly on the "Literacy" of mathematics ensuring consistency in line with Dr Paul Swan developmental scales.
